**Monthly Producer Assessment Report
General Instructions**

California Food and Agriculture code requires that all vintners withhold an assessment on all Crush District #11 winegrapes acquired from producers and remit the assessment to the Lodi Winegrape Commission.

Assessment Rate: For the marketing season beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021 the assessment rate shall be 0.45% (45 cents per hundred dollars) of the gross dollar value of winegrapes grown in and acquired from Crush District #11.

Collection of Grower Assessment: The vintner is required to deduct the assessment for the 2020-2021 marketing season from payments made to producers of Crush District #11 winegrapes, remit the assessment during the following month directly to the Commission, and file assessment reports documenting the amount remitted. Note: Certain producer exemptions do apply. However, the vintner is required to deduct the producer assessment from payments made to producers regardless of how many tons of winegrapes the producer is believed to have grown. If a producer supplies the vintner with a Commission-generated Certificate of Exemption, a deduction is not required. Producers may apply to the Commission for a certificate of exemption or a refund if they believe they are exempt from assessment.

Due Dates and Remittance Advice: Producer assessment payments are due and payable on the last day of the month following the month in which payments are made by vintners to producers and remitted to:

Special note regarding assessment due dates: In the event a vintner has not paid for its Crush District #11 winegrapes acquired from producers by March 31, 2021 it must compute the total remaining payments due the producer, calculate the total remaining assessment due on these outstanding payments, and remit the assessment on the March 2021 payment form. The gross dollar value of any unpriced winegrapes must be calculated by using the weighted average grower return per ton for Crush District #11 as it appears in the Final Grape Crush Report.

Penalties: The postmark on the remittance envelope containing the assessment payment and assessment report shall be considered the date of payment regardless of the date entered on the forms. Delinquent assessments will be subject to a 10% penalty plus a 1.5% late fee for each 30 days, or portion thereof, that the delinquent balance is unpaid. Failure of the vintner to collect assessments from a producer shall not exempt the vintner from liability nor relieve the producer of the obligation to pay the assessment.

Custom Crush Activity: California Food and Agriculture code requires producers to pay an assessment on winegrapes grown in Crush District #11 and custom crushed for producers. The Commission will be contacting vintners in November 2020 for the names, addresses of producers, and quantities of Crush District #11 winegrapes custom crushed.

Warning: It is a violation of California Food and Agriculture code to fail to furnish or willfully furnish false reports, statements, or records to the Commission, or to fail or refuse to furnish names and addresses of producers from which Crush District #11 winegrapes were received.
