Marketing & promotions

The Committee agreed that producing LODI RULES vineyard tech sheets and a LODI RULES illustrated explainer video would benefit the program. It was also decided that due to the growth of interest in the program over the last few years, it is a good time to get professional consultation to strategize program promotion for the next 3-5 years. Dr. Bolton will begin working with estreetco to identify opportunities, prioritize marketing actions, and execute on some of our many promotional ideas for a diverse audience. Through this consultation, we will be able to better maximize the value derived from our budget.

Program improvements

 The Committee reviewed revisions to the LODI RULES standard farming practices, which will continue through August.

Winery communications

 There is a need to communicate with the marketing directors of wineries using a seal.

- Protected Harvest and SureHarvest news
 - Some LODI RULES audits will be conducted via online video conferencing this year due to Covid-19 safety concerns.
- Pesticide restrictions from wineries
 - No updates, but something to keep watching.
- Pesticide Risk Model for 2020 certification year & beyond
 - The members and growers who volunteered to pilot the new pesticide risk tool have been in close communication with Ariel Larson at IPMI. Ms. Larson is responsive to input and they are working to make the reporting system for PRT more user-friendly.
- 6. The FY2019-2020 Budget through June 2020 and FY2020-2021 Draft Budget were reviewed.
